

**MEMORY FOR 6th Grade - 1st quarter
2022-23**

Why do we memorize God's Word? God tells us in 2 Timothy 3:14-17:

“But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it, and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work.”

Memory is an important part of the Lutheran School curriculum. We will be memorizing verses from the Bible (ESV) and selected hymns as well as parts of Luther’s Small Catechism (originally written for parents to use to instruct their children on the basic teachings of the Bible). Verses will either be recited orally or written. We will be reviewing many of the same verses throughout the year.

You are responsible for **two verses per week** most weeks of the school year. Memory verses are due usually on Tuesday and Friday, yet may be said early. About every other week you will also complete a **memory meditation** in your online Devotion Journal. This memory packet will help you plan your week and organize your time.
